

FirstEnergy RFP for 2018 Ohio Compliant RECs - FAQs

Below is the list of FAQs received from bidders to date:

1. What is the process for entering an application for credit approval for the FirstEnergy RFP?
 - Once you have set up an account here: <https://feohiorecrfp.com/>.
 - Go to “Application Dashboard” on the top menu bar and select “submit an application,” and the following screen will appear.
 - Click on “Credit Application Form – 2018” to proceed through the four-screen process of applying.

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Submit a Bid Application

Submit only one Credit Application Form and only one Qualifying Application Form for the proposing entity.

Submit one Bid Price Proposal form for each distinct bid by the proposing entity.

The open application period is October 2, 2018 at 9AM EPT to November 6, 2018 at 5PM EPT.

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2. Does first energy plan to award all RECs or SRECs to one bidding entity or multiple entities?

The bid evaluation criteria are described in Section 10 of the Bidding Rules. The RFP Manager will select Bid Price Proposals by price for each category (REC and SREC) up to the target quantities sought by FirstEnergy Ohio Utilities in this RFP. The quantity of RECs or SRECs supplied by the lowest cost bidder(s) will be the basis of the RFP Manager’s recommendation as to the entities awarded contracts. All Bid Price Proposals will be considered an offer by the

bidder to supply any quantity up to and including the quantity specified in the Bid. In the event of “tied” Bid Price Proposals (e.g., bids with the same offer price) preference will be given to (i) projects that are physically located within the State of Ohio and (ii) the larger volume Proposal. FirstEnergy Ohio Utilities reserves the right to select more or fewer than the target quantities sought in this RFP. FirstEnergy Ohio Utilities reserves the right to limit the total amount from any one party to preserve a diversity of suppliers.

3. What is the current value and 2019 value for RECs and SRECS?

FirstEnergy is running a competitive solicitation to get the best REC and SREC price for its customers. The 2019 REC and SREC value will be determined by the lowest cost bids received. Bidders are advised to conduct their own due diligence.
