



FirstEnergy RFP for 2021 Ohio Compliant RECs - FAQs

Below are FAQs received from bidders and responses.

1. How can I revise an application document once submitted?

Up until the application due date (November 10, 2021 at 5PM ET), bidders may revise and resubmit their application documents. If you'd like to do so, please contact the RFP Manager at manager@feohiorecrfp.com to request that your application be opened for revision.

2. Can RECs be delivered via M-RETS?

FirstEnergy Ohio Utilities requires RECs be delivered via PJM-EIS GATS, reflecting the location of The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, Ohio Edison Company, and The Toledo Edison Company as within PJM-served territory.

3. Is The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company doing business as The Illuminating Company?

The Illuminating Company is a trademark. The Purchase and Sale Agreement (PSA) has been updated to reflect The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company. The updated Purchase and Sale Agreement has been posted to the website.

4. Have there been other updates to the PSA?

Yes. The PSA signature page was updated to reflect that FirstEnergy Service Company is serving as agent for The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, Ohio Edison Company and The Toledo Edison Company. The PSA was also updated to include "The" before each reference to The Toledo Edison Company. The updated PSA was posted on Nov. 3, 2021.

5. Will FirstEnergy allow legal edits by the supplier to the PSA?

The terms and conditions included in the PSA are final and non-negotiable.

6. What entity would a bidder face credit-wise if success in this RFP?

FirstEnergy Service Company is the named counterparty under the PSA.
